INTRODUCTION




FIGURE 1: LOCATION OF THE PROPOSED AREA

Umlando cc was contracted by Exigent Environmental cc, to undertake a heritage survey of a proposed development for the Birdswood Primary School, Richards Bay, KwaZulu-Natal (see fig. 1).

The area is archaeologically sensitive and sites may occur in the proposed area. A survey should be undertaken once bush clearance has occurred, but before construction begins.
