

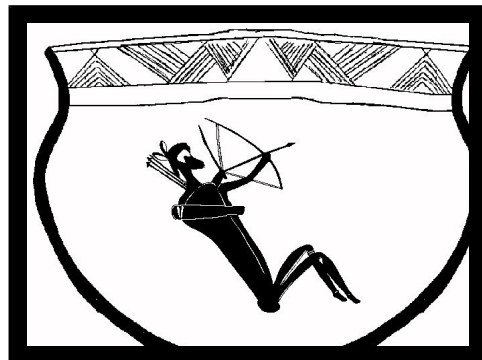

Umlando undertook its monthly survey of the Hillendale mine. A new area¹ had been cleared that was previously noted as being sensitive.

Several artefacts were observed on the surface. These include:

- Pottery:
 - Mostly thin-walled and undecorated. These probably date to the Late Iron Age or Historical Period
 - A few Ntshokane sherds, of which one was thin-walled and decorated
- Stone: A few upper grinding stones
- Bone: A few fragments of (assumed) domestic bovid. These are on the surface and can date from last year backwards.

Some of the pottery sherds were sampled.
