## KWACELE SUBSIDISED RURAL HOUSING

K2m Environmental is undertaking the EIA for the proposed housing upgrade study. The total extend of the proposed housing project area is approximately 1928.91Ha. The project area is located on a portion of Ward 2 the Umdoni Local Municipality. The project area falls within the jurisdiction of the Umdoni Local Municipality, which is one of six local municipalities making up the uGu District Municipality. The in-situ houses to be built are approximately 2000.

The development is rated as having moderate palaeontological sensitivity (fig. 1) and would normally require a desktop study asf a minimum requirement. However the area is highly disturbed and the palaeontological layers tend to occur ~1.5m below the surface. The housing development will not be reaching these depths.

There are no known archaeological sites within the study area. While they will occur in the study the proposed project will not affect any sites (fig. 2).

The proposed development will only occur in the footprints of existing homesteads and thus will not impact heritage sites or graves. Any graves occurring within a settlement near a footprint will be known to the household and would not be affected. I support the request that no further heritage management occurs for this development.
