### DESCRIPTION

EIGHT SLAG SAMPLES. - FIVE ARE ROUGH + FRACED WITH LESS EVIDENCE OF CONFLUENCE THAN OTHER THREE. TRAUGHTS OF FIVE ROUGH ARTIFACTS ARE MOSTLY FILLED WITH ROUGH GRAINED FINE GRAVEL/CLINKER TYPE DEPOSITS, ALL HAVE SOME EVIDENCE OF BLACK HORN RIDGES/VEINS EXPOSED. ONE FRACKED SAMPLE HAS DISTINCT CONVEX SHAPE ON ONE SIDE AND THE EROSION HERE IS MORE UNIFORM WITH PATTERNED ALMOST SPHERICAL HOLES. THREE SAMPLES ARE ITAKO SMOOTH + MOSTLY BLACK. ONE VERY CONFUSED + TWISTED + MOULDED INTO 'SCULPTURE' SHAPE. ONE HAS VERY DISTINCT SPHERICAL DIP IN SURFACE WHICH IS SMOOTH WITH SHARP EDGES. THE HOLES ON THE THREE HORN SMOOTH SAMPLES ARE CLEAN AND SMOOTH WITH NO EVIDENCE OF EROSION BY AGE. SAMPLES ARE ORANGEY/BROWN / BLACK. HARD SAMPLES HAVE 'BLOOM'.


