DESCRIPTION

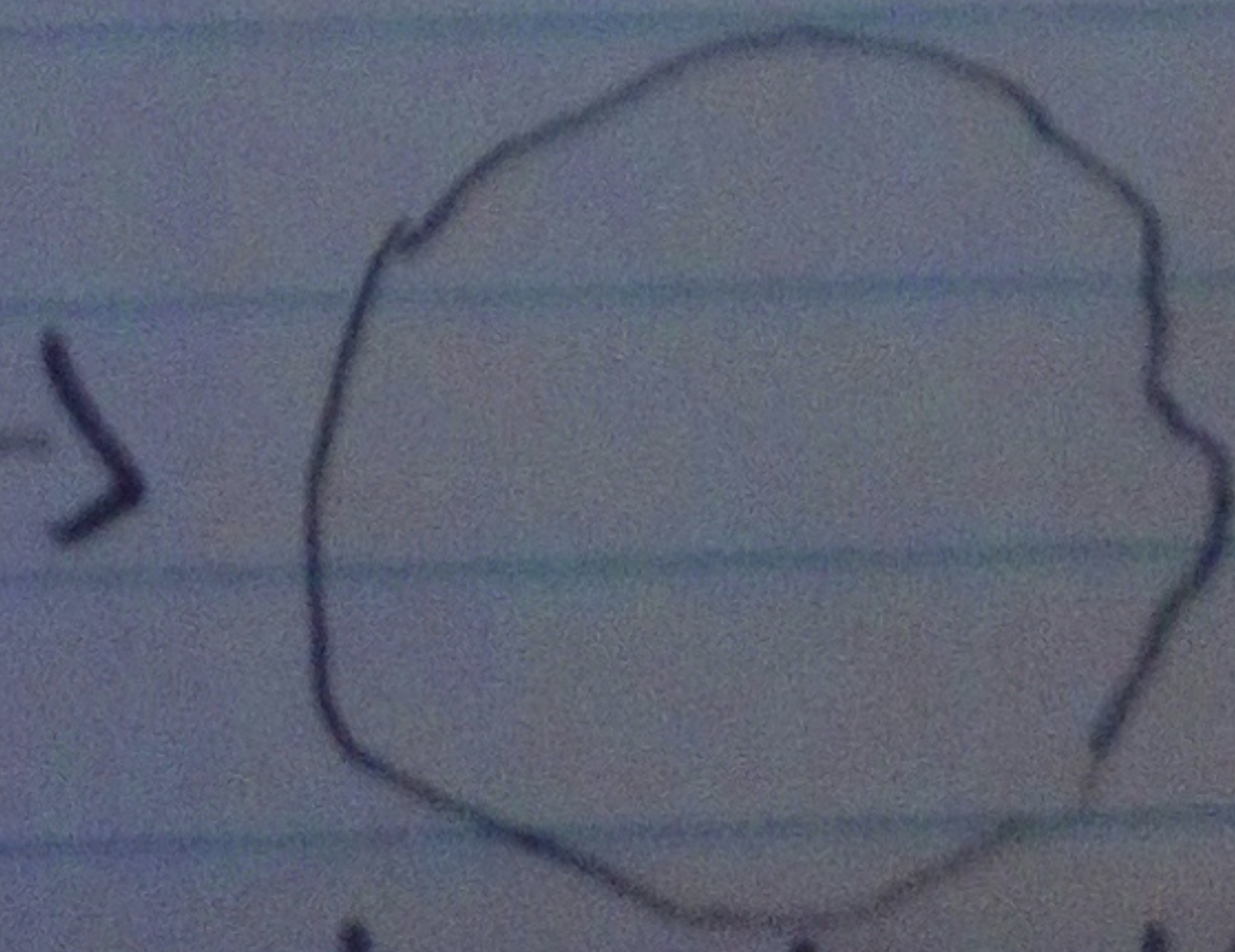
EIGHT SLAG SAMPLES. - FIVE ARE ROUGH + FLAKED WITH LESS EVIDENCE OF CONFLUION THAN OTHER THREE. THROUGHTS OF FIVE ROUGH ARTEFACTS ARE MOSTLY FILLED WITH ROUGH GRAINED FINE GRAVEL/CLINKER TYPE DEPOSITS. ALL HAVE SOME EVIDENCE OF BLACK HARD RIDGES/VEINS EXPOSED. ONE FLAKED SAMPLE HAS DISTINCT CONVEX SHAPE ON ONE SIDE AND THE EROSION HERE IS MORE UNIFORM WITH PATTERNED ALMOST SPHERICAL HOLES. THREE SAMPLES ARE HARD SMOOTH + MOSTLY BLACK. ONE VERY CONFLUTED + TWISTED + MOULDED INTO 'SCULPTURE' SHAPE. ONE HAS VERY DISTINCT SPHERICAL DIP IN SURFACE WHICH IS SMOOTH WITH SHARP EDGES. THE HOLES ON THE THREE HARD SMOOTH SAMPLES ARE CLEAN AND SMOOTH WITH NO EVIDENCE OF EROSION BY AGE. SAMPLES ARE ORANGY/BROWN/BLACK. HARD SAMPLES HAVE 'BLOOM'.
