DESCRIPTION

A. FLATTENED SEMI CIRCLE. EDGES ON STRAIGHTISH SIDE SUGGEST ORIGINALLY FORMED PART OF A LARGER OBJECT. ROUGH HARD TEXTURE SLIGHT PITTING, FLAKES AND EROSION. LIGHT, MID AND DARK BROWN MOTTLED COLOUR

B. SMALLER AND DARKER IN COLOUR THAN A. MORE RED. BROWN TO BLACK. TEXTURE IS HARD BUT NOT AS ROUGH. SMOOTHER SURFACE LESS PITTED NO FLAKES.
