Born in York. His father was an artist and teacher, all of whose sons followed in his footsteps. Albert, the youngest, was an extremely fine draughtsman and received his training first with his father and brothers and later at the York School of Design and the Royal Academy Schools. He was a decorative artist who did much work for architects, besides designing wall-papers, tiles, fabrics, etc.
