DESCRIPTION - TUYERE BROKEN IN TWO PIECES - SMALLER SECTION WITH DEPOSITS FILLING MUCH OF THE CORE. ONE END WITH THIN OUTER WALL, REMAINDER OUTER SKIN NORMAL SIZE, INCREASED WITH DEPOSITS. EXTERNAL SKIN MOSTLY HARD SMOOTHISH WITH HARD MOLTEN RAISED CRUPTIONS. SOME EVIDENCE OF 'FIBRE' IN THE WALL VERY SMALL THIN STRANDS? PLANT ROOTS.

b) LARGER SECTION COMPLETELY BLOCKED WITH DEPOSITS THICK OUTER SKIN/WALL AT ONE END DIFFICULT TO SEE WHERE WALL ENDS + INTERNAL DEPOSITS BEGIN. HARD SMOOTHISH SURFACE WITH SOME MOLTEN CRUPTIONS SOME FIBRES IN SAMPLE WALL + IN INTERNAL 'PIPE'. ? PLANT ROOTS. COLOR ORANGY BROWN DARK BROWN.
