 - 4.2 There is no new land or green fields identified, for clearance of indigenous vegetation that will be above the threshold.
 - 4.3 There are no features of cultural or heritage significance within the vicinity of the proposed site.
 - 4.4 The new 1 500 houses will be located within existing cleared areas and where vegetation has been previously been disturbed.
