AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 09 JULY 2014 FOR THE PROPOSED 75MW PV4 PHOTOVOLTAIC ENERGY PLANT ON THE FARM HOEKPLAAS NO. 146 NEAR COPPERTON, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the abovementioned application by this Department on 09 July 2014, the amendment to the EA dated 10 October 2014 and 25 April 2016, and your application for amendment of the EA received by the Department on 10 March 2017 refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, has decided to amend the EA dated 09 July 2014, as amended as follows:

The applicant applied to change the contact details of the holder of the EA, as the contact details has changed since the EA was issued.

Amendment 2: Amendment to extend the validity period of the EA:

The activity must commence within a period of three (03) years from the date of expiry of the EA issued on 09 July 2014 as amended (i.e. the EA lapses on 09 July 2020). If commencement of the activity does not occur within that period, the authorisation lapses and a new application for environmental authorisation must be made in order for the activity to be undertaken.

The applicant applied to extend the validity period of the EA as the development was not awarded preferred bidder status in the DoE REIPPP. The applicant intends to bid this project in the DoE REIPPP future rounds.

This proposed amendment letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 09 July 2014 as amended.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision in respect of your application as well as the fact that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of the National Appeals Regulations, and the provisions regarding the submission of appeals as contained in the Regulations.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
