**EXTENSION FOR THE VALIDITY PERIOD OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF FILLING STATION AND RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT ON PORTION 42 OF THE FARM RONDEBOSCH 287 LS WITHIN MAKHADO LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF VHEMBE DISTRICT**

The application requesting for the extension of validity period of the Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued on 16 November 2011 for the above-mentioned development refers.

The Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism ("the Department") acknowledges the receipt of the application, submitted by Phakanani Environmental on 22 October 2014 requesting an extension of the validity period in respect of the proposed construction of filling station and residential development. The proposed development is situated on the south western side of the intersection road of N1, P98-1 (R578) and D2554, on portion 42 of the farm Rondebosch 287 LS within Makhado Local Municipality of Vhembe District.

The Department reviewed the application submitted and hereby grants **Zimzeni 281 cc** an extension of the validity period for the EA as follows:

1. The validity of the EA issued on 16 November 2011 has been extended with further 3 years from date of signature of this letter;
2. All the conditions in the EA already issued for this project are still legitimate and must be adhered to;
3. If commencement of the proposed activity does not take place within the specified period, a new application for EA must be lodged with the competent authority in terms Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations and National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) (NEMA) as amended;
4. Should the proposed activity commence any time after the expiry date, it will be considered as an illegal development; and
5. All the interested and/or affected parties registered for this project must be notified about this extension and the conditions it is subject to, within 14 days of signature of this letter.


