The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the abovementioned application by this Competent Authority (CA) on 27 July 2021, your application for amendment of the EA received by the CA on 15 September 2022 and the acknowledgement letter dated 26 September 2022, refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this CA, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 as amended, has decided to amend the EA dated 27 July 2021, as follows:

Amendment 1: To increase the capacity of the facility on page 1 and 6 (project description) of the EA

#### Reason for amendment:

Solar PV technology has improved significantly, with substantially higher efficiency levels from new PV panels of the same size. It is therefore possible to generate more energy from the same development envelope through the implementation of the latest technology. The panels themselves are of similar size as it is the photovoltaic cells which are more efficient, therefore resulting in an increased output capacity from panels within the approved development envelope (810ha). The realised benefit is an increased capacity with no other physical changes to the planned facility (1MW of PV requires approximately 1.5ha, and therefore 480MW can be accommodated within 810ha). The utilisation of more efficient panels will result in an increase in the total generation capacity of the facility.

This proposed amendment letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 27 July 2021.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within fourteen (14) days of the date of the decision, of the Department's decision as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the EIA Regulations.

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No. 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. Further your attention is drawn to the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act No. 4 of 2013) which stipulate that the Department should conduct itself in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing an individual or another entity's personal information by holding the Department accountable should the Department abuse or compromise your personal information in any way.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within twenty (20) days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.


