
**ECPHRA FINAL COMMENTS:

- For any in-situ fossil finds during construction phase, the developers need to adhere to Phase 2 minimum standard of collecting paleontological material and would need a permit from ECPHRA for mitigation.

- The responsible specialists must adhere to best international practise.
