

- b) Provide interim and final comments from South African Heritage Resource Agency (SAHRA).
- c) Provide comments or proof of application from the Department of Water and Sanitation regarding the water use licence.
- d) Public participation process must be conducted up to satisfactory, provide a full public participation process as stipulated in chapter 6 of EIA regulation 2014. This includes notification of landowners, public meetings etc.
- e) According to environmental screening the proposed prospecting activities will occur on a very highly sensitive ecological support areas, therefore relevant specialist study is required.
