7. Make available financial provision to the amount of **R78 607.00** either in the form of cash deposit into **DME Rehabilitation Trust account, account no.4067034181 (ABSA)** or bank guarantee from any registered bank of South African bank.
8. You are therefore requested to address the above on/or before **10th of April 2017**:
