Issued under Section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

to: Mr E. Seamark (ID: 7312125051088),

of: Gauteng Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Environment,

for: the removal of a rock fig from within a kiln for the preservation of the kiln (also includes a prickly pear (Opuntia),

at: Drimolen, at approximately 25.58.08S, 27.45.21E,

on: the erf 519 JQ, Sterkfontein,

in: the Krugersdorp, District, Gauteng Province.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. After cutting back the tree as close as possible to the roots, poison should be applied carefully so as not to contaminate any historical residues.
- 2. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
- 3. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 1 January 2010. SAHRA reserves the right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory.
- 4. The licensed permit holder shall be responsible for the activities and impacts of all colleagues, students and employees under his or her supervision and for their compliance with the terms of the Heritage Agreement and the Management Plan for this site.
- The permit holder including colleagues, visitors, students and employees under the direct supervision of the permit holder must carry documents of identification indicating their legitimacy to be on the National Heritage Site.
- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to protect sites during and after work and to ensure that where appropriate the site is stabilized with adequate materials.
- 7. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 8. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
- 9. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.
