

3. In addition, where more significant archaeological or palaeontological deposits are encountered, the specialist must be given adequate time to document, rescue and/or guide on the way forward.

4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
