TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

to: Ms Christine Sievers (Scott) (ID 5510230081088),
of: 8 Portland Crescent, Durban North, 4051,
for: the temporary export of 28 whole seeds and 16 fragments of carbonised seeds,
from: Middle Stone Age levels at Sibudu Cave,
for: identification and comparison with specimens at the Institute of Archaeology,
University College, London.

The following conditions apply:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.

5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 July 2007 at the expense of Ms Christine Sievers.
6. It is understood that Professor Wadley has approved this temporary export.
7. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 July 2007.
8. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
9. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
10. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
