EXPORT PERMIT

No. 80/11/08/007/52

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

- to: Dr M Chazan,
- of: the Department of Anthropology, University of Toronto, 100 St George Street, Toronto, Ontario, MSS1A1,
- for: the permanent export of loose geological sample collected from Bestwood 2 for chemical and mineralogical analysis and block geological samples from Bestwood 1 for impregnation and sectioning for morphological analysis of site formation processes. Included in the permanent export are unworked slabs and loose sediment samples (about 5g per sample) of sediment collected from Wonderwerk Cave. In addition, for the temporary export of unidentifiable bone fragments from Wonderwerk Cave for analysis to indentify evidence of burning,
- from: the McGregor Museum, Northern Cape Province,
- to: Dr M Chazan,
- of: Department of Anthropology, University of Toronto, 100 St George Street, Toronto, Ontario, MSS1A1, Canada.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
- 2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the McGregor Museum.
- 3. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the repository, McGregor Museum.
- 4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr M Chazan without the consent of SAHRA.
- 5. The material on temporary loan shall be returned to South Africa on or before 01 October 2012 at the expense of Dr M Chazan).
- 6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 01 October 2012.
- 7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.

9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
