TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

- to: Dr MA Raath (ID: 4102115099087) on behalf of Dr Lucinda Backwell,
- of: the BPI Palaeontology, University of the Witwatersrand, Private Bag 3, Wits, 2050,
- for: the temporary export of 21 pieces of worked bone from Howiesonspoort levels, 5 post-Howiesonspoort and 2 pre-Still Bay pieces (total of 28 worked bone pieces) and in addition, 60 shells which include 20 Howiesonspoort, 20 Still Bay and 20 pre-Still Bay pieces,
- from: Professor Lynn Wadley, excavated at Sibudu Shelter, Inanda, KwaZulu Natal Province,
- to: Dr. Francesco d'Errico, Directeur de recherché au CNRS, Institut de Préhistoire et de Géologie du Quaternaire, CNRS UMR 5199 PACEA, Université Bordeaux 1, avenue des Facultés, F-33405 Talence, France,
- for: for analysis which will entail description and interpretation of the fossils and microscopic analysis using scanning electron and optical methods.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
- 2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the custodian.
- 3. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the custodian.
- 4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr. d'Errico without the consent of SAHRA.
- 5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 December 2007 at the expense of Dr d'Errico.
- 6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 December 2007.
- 7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
- 10. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.
