- 1. A monitoring report on activities related to this permit must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 01 August 2014.
- 2. Where more significant archaeological deposits or fossiliferous deposits are encountered in the subterrain, work must be halted and the archaeologist or SAHRA notified immediately to provide counsel.
- 3. In addition, where more significant archaeological or palaeontological deposits are encountered, the specialist must be given adequate time to document, rescue and/ or guide on the way forward.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 6. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the developer to ensure that conditions of this permit are adhered to.
