TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT No. 80/09/07/011/62

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999.

Permission is hereby given:

- to: Dr Bernhard Zipfel,
of: the Bernard Price Institute for Palaeontological Research, Private Bag 3, University of the Witwatersrand, WITS, 2050,
for: the temporary export of unsorted matrix (loan no 369) from strata at Driefontein,
for: identification and analysis,
to: Dr Patrick Lewis of the Department of Biological Sciences, Sam Houston University, Box 2116, Huntsville, Texas 77341.

The following conditions apply:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers and the material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the Bernard Price Institute, Wits.
3. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the repository, Bernard Price Institute, Wits.
4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr P Lewis without the consent of SAHRA.
5. It is noted that the Driefontein locality has yielded interesting, rare and important dinosaur fossils, primarily Massospondylus. Extensive preparation, analysis and comparison, in collaboration with researchers at the BPI, is necessary in order to identify these fossils. Dr Lewis is a research collaborator and is in a position to sort and identify these fauna.
6. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 January 2013 at the expense of Dr Patrick Lewis.
7. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before January 2013.
8. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
9. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
10. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
11. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.

This permit is valid until 1 January 2013.
