## PERMANENT EXPORT PERMIT

No. 80/11/05/012/52

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

- to: Prof. Andrew B. Smith (ID: 4101025113186),
- of: the Department of Archaeology, University of Cape Town, Private Bag, Rondebosch, 7700,
- for: the export of limpet shells from 40 archaeological layers from Kasteelberg B,
- from: the Pre-Colonial collections of Iziko Museum, Cape Town,
- to: Dr. Thomas A. Brown,
- of: the Centre of Accelerator Mass Spectrometry, Lawrence Livermore Laboratories, California, 94550, USA,
- for: dating.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. Each artefact or specimen must be clearly marked with the accession number.
- 2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the IZIKO: South African Museum.
- 3. The number of shell samples exported may not exceed 50% of the limpet shells present in any layer.
- 4. The samples must be kept for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged. Any unused samples must be returned to Iziko.
- 5. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 01 July 2012.
- 6. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 7. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
