### **PERMIT**

Issued under Section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999.  
Permission is hereby given:

of: Archaeomaps, Postnet Suite 239, Private Bag X3, Beacon Bay, 5205,  
for: collection of Stone Age artefacts from Stone Age Area 1 (S31°28'27.0";  
E25°00'02.1") and Stone Age Area 2 (S31°29'20.4"; E27°59'37.9") and for monitoring  
and where necessary collection of Colonial Period artefacts from a British Military  
Camp (S31°28'27.0"; E25°00'02.1") along proposed line route 3 of the Middleburg  
Provision of Water Project,  
on: the farm Grootfontein 81, near Middelburg,  
in: the Chris Hani District Municipality District, Eastern Cape Province.

The following conditions apply:

1. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be used. Note that the position of all excavations must be marked on a plan of each site.
4. All material as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the Albany Museum.
5. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 01 March 2013. SAHRA reserves the right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory.
6. Reprints of all published papers, or copies of theses or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
8. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
9. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to fill in excavations and protect sites during and after excavation to the satisfaction of SAHRA and the landowner.
10. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
11. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
