TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT No. 80/08/06/021/52

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

to: Professor Lyn Wadley,

of: the Department of Archaeology, University of the Witwatersrand, Private Bag 3, Wits, 2050,

for: the temporary export of 20 glass beads that have been selected for the chemical testing (7 red beads, 6 blue/green beads, 2 yellow, 2 small green and 3 blue beads),

from: Square B4b, layer BSV, in the Iron Age layers;

at: Sibudu Cave, Inanda, KwaZulu Natal Province,

to: Dr L Dussebieuxe,

of: LA-ICP-MS Laboratory, Department of Anthropology, Field Museum of Natural History, 1400 S Lake Shore Drive, Chicago, IL 60605 USA,

for: chemical analysis to establish the age and origin of the beads.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
- 2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the University of Witwatersrand.
- 3. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the repository, University of Witwatersrand.
- 4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr L Dussebieuxe without the consent of SAHRA.
- 5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 August 2009 at the expense of Dr L Dussebieuxe.
- 6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 August 2009.
- 7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
- 10. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.
