Gen. William Nicolay Circa 1819) to his son Dr. Bryan Maynard Nicolay in the United Kingdom, as part of his inheritance.

The objects may not be sold during the 14 day window period from the issuing of this permit.
- SAHRA shall not be held liable for any losses incurred resulting from the suspension of the permit. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
