This permit is issued to Prof Anusuya Chinsamy-Turan (Department of Biological Sciences, University of Cape Town) for invasive sampling of three ribs, one metatarsal II, two tibiae, one radius and one fibula of *Massospondylus carinatus* specimen NMQR3963 from the Elliot Formation (Karoo Supergroup) for osteohistological analysis at UCT. Specimens were selected due to their uncertain provenance and fragmentary nature. The material is currently housed in the National Museum Bloemfontein.

Conditions:

1. Sampling may not reduce the structural integrity, overall completeness or the potential for future morphometric and descriptive research.
2. Analysis will take place in the Department of Biological Sciences at the University of Cape Town.
3. No holotype or paratype material may be sampled.
