### In terms of Section 27(23) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

**Site:** Taung Skull World Heritage Site, North West Province, South Africa (Taung Skull World Heritage Site)

1. Crew members on site during filming will be the Director, DOP, Sound Recorder and Technical Assistant.
2. Monitoring and supervision must be done by Ms Bando Gaven, Ms Lebo Diale or Mr Mzi Nkabi (to be delegated by North West READ).
3. Filming will take place in the Taung World Heritage Site.
