## PERMIT: Destruction

**In terms of Section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)**

**Site:** Late Iron Age stonewalled site on the farm Zwartkoppies 364 JR (P3-1, P3-2, P3-7, P3-10)

**This permit is issued to Mr Munyadziwa Magoma (Vhubvo Consultancy Cc) for the destruction of three (3) Late Iron Age stonewalled sites (P3-1; P3-2; P3-10) and one (1) historic stonewall (P3-7) on the farm Zwartkoppies 364 JR, situated east of Pretoria, Gauteng Province, which will be affected by the laying of a pipe line between Mamelodi and Vlaktefontein. Mr Munyadziwa Magoma will be monitoring the site while disturbance of the stone wall is undertaken. This permit serves as a renewal of four expired permits (PermitIDs 2230, 2231, 2235 and 2237) that were previously approved by SAHRA.**

### Conditions:

1. If Mr Munyadziwa Magoma is not to be present on the sites at all times, then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Monitoring of the sites by Mr Munyadziwa Magoma, or a representative approved by SAHRA, is compulsory for the entire duration of the work undertaken in proximity of the four sites.
3. Site P3-7 must be adequately recorded using methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act. The position of all stones removed must be marked on a plan of site. The sites P3-1; P3-2; P3-10 were well recorded during the first and second assessment and as such SAHRA does not require any further recording.
4. The stones removed from the wall of site P3-7 must be stored on site in a manner which is found most suitable by the archaeologist and which does not compromise the authenticity of the site.
5. A permit report on the results of the destruction including photographic records and site plan (as per condition 3) must be emailed to [apmpermitreports@sahra.org.za](mailto:apmpermitreports@sahra.org.za) on or before 31 March 2021, using the template in the following link: <https://sahris.sahra.org.za/content/apmpermitreports>. SAHRA reserves the

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right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory. Permit reports can be made available to researchers on request within three years of the lapsing of this permit.

6. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with SAHRA.

7. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit. Conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.

8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.

9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.

10. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.

11. Request to renew permits must be done at least two months prior to the expiry of the existing permit.
