The permit is issued to Prof Christopher Henshilwood (Evolutionary Studies Institute, University of the Witwatersrand), in collaboration with Dr Turid Hillestad Nel (SFF Centre for Early Sapiens Behaviour, University of Bergen, Norway), to temporarily export teeth from eight micromammal species from Klipdrift Shelter and Klasies River main site for analysis of stable carbon and oxygen isotopes at the Stable Isotope Laboratory, Department of Archaeology, Max Planck Institute for the Science of Human History, Jena, Germany. The material is currently housed at the Iziko Museums in Cape Town.

Conditions:

1. Only the selected representatives of the material stored in the collection may be exported.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the name of the site (if known), and the name and address of the permit holder or the Iziko Museums.
3. The material will be couriered via DHL to Max Planck Institute for the Science of Human History, Jena, Germany.
4. Dr Hillestad Nel and Dr Patrick Roberts are responsible for the analysis of the material and Prof Christopher Henshilwood for its transport to and from the above mentioned institutions/collections.
5. The samples must be used for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged.
6. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than the above stated participants in the study, without the consent of SAHRA.
