**Object:** Cattle tooth\_Castle, Cattle tooth\_Elsenburg

**The permit is issued to Dr Judith Sealy (Department of Archaeology, University of Cape Town) for the temporarily export of 10 cattle teeth from the Castle of Good Hope Collection (6 teeth) and Elsenburg Collection (4 teeth) for ancient DNA analysis at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Ludwig Maximilians University, Germany. The material is currently housed at the Department of Archaeology, University of Cape Town.**

Conditions:

1. Only the selected representatives of the material stored in the collection may be exported.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the name of the site (if known), and the name and address of the permit holder or the Department of Archaeology, University of Cape Town.
3. The material will be couriered to Ludwig Maximilians University, Germany.
4. Prof Laurent Franz (Ludwig Maximilians University) is responsible for the analysis of the material and Dr Judith Sealy for its transport to and from the above mentioned institutions/collections.
5. The samples must be used for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged.
6. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than the above stated participants in the study, without the consent of SAHRA.
7. Destructive analysis or sampling may be undertaken. The material must be recorded photographically in detail (before and after picture) prior to any invasive analysis.
