Object: bulk export bovids southern SA

The permit is issued to Dr Gideon de Jager (University of Pretoria), to temporarily export 59 bone and teeth fragments of six bovid species from the sites Boomplaas Cave, Die Kelders Cave, Elands Bay Cave, Elands Bay Open, Klasies River Mouth Caves, Nelson Bay Cave, Pinnacle Point Cave Complex (54 from Iziko Museum; two from Florisbad Quaternary Research Station of the National Museum Bloemfontein; one from Ditsong: National Museum of Natural History), including one historical sample (*Buffalo caffer*, 115 y.o., Amathole Museum) and one specimen of unknown provenance (*Pelorovis antiquus*, Ditsong: National Museum of Natural History), for sampling and stable isotope analyses at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark.

Conditions:

1. Only the selected representatives of the material stored in the collections may be exported.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the name of the site (if known), and the name and address of the permit holder or the respective museum.
3. The material will be couriered to University of Copenhagen, Denmark.
4. Dr Gideon de Jager is responsible for the analysis of the material and its transport to and from the above mentioned institutions/collections.
5. The samples must be used for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged.
6. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than the above stated participants in the study, without the consent of SAHRA.
7. Destructive sampling may be undertaken after the specimen are suitably recorded.
