Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

for: the export of undisturbed blocks of about 40 samples (some from previously excavated samples) roughly 8-10 cm on a side, to be impregnated with polyester resin, cut with a rock saw and manufactured into petrographic thin sections. In addition about 40 sediment samples (about 150gm per sample) will be taken from the same locations as micromorphology samples for chemical and physical assays,
