The material is currently housed at the National Museum Bloemfontein.

Conditions:

1. Only the selected representatives of the material stored in the collection may be exported.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the name of the site (if known), and the name and address of the permit holder or the National Museum Bloemfontein.
3. The material must be hand-carried or couriered to IRAMAT-CRP2A, Maison de l'Archéologie, Bordeaux Montaigne University, Pessac (France), and at the Centro Nacional de Investigacion sobre la Evolucion Humana (CENIEH), Burgos (Spain).
4. Dr Michael Toffolo (IRAMAT-CRP2A) and Dr Maïlys Richard (CENIEH) are responsible for the analysis of the material, and Dr Lloyd Rossouw and Dr Michael Toffolo for its transport to the above mentioned institutions/collections.
5. The samples must be used for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged.
