The permit is issued to Prof. Nicholas Conrad (University of Tübingen) and Dr. Manuel Will (University of Tübingen) for the export and destructive analysis of 500 unidentified bone fragments from Sibhudu Cave, KwaZulu-Natal. The materials are currently housed at the KwaZulu-Natal Museum, Pietermaritzburg.

7. Destructive analysis or sampling may be undertaken. Unused samples or the remaining samples must be returned to the KwaZulu-Natal Museum, Pietermaritzburg by 31 March 2023.
