Demolition of fire damaged building and proposed replacement buildings at 182 Church street Rem of Ptn 2 of erf 2518 Pietermaritzburg, KwaZulu Natal.

1.1 That the work is carried out strictly in accordance with the revised application submitted on the 21/10/2022 and **TCRPV Architects drawing nos. 4265 - 001, -200, -300, -700, Dated: 03 February 2023 uploaded on the 27 February 2023** and that the work is overseen by Lindsay Napier and David Vigar, with details and specifications submitted to Amafa.

1.2 The KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute will not further condone any work conducted prior obtaining a permit.

1.3 A close-out report is required upon completion of construction

1.4 That in the event of any contemplated deviation, the prior **written approval** of the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute must be obtained;

1.5 In such event, a <u>written motivation</u> in support of such deviation must be submitted to KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute for consideration and;

1.6 The KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute has the right to inspect the site at any time;

1.7 Where necessary monthly reports are to be submitted to the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute on the work being conducted and the findings;

1.8 A final report on the work conducted and the findings must be submitted to the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute not later than thirty (30) days from the date of expiration of this permit, extensions are

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negotiable;

1.9 All salvageable material not required for re-use on the site must be offered to the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute and selected material must be delivered to the repository at Midmar at the applicant's cost;

1.10 The KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute must be contacted immediately upon discovery of any archaeological material, including human remains.

1.11 All archaeological and paleontological material becomes the property of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal and must be lodged at the repository the Institute.

1.12 That a copy of this permit is kept on the premises at all times during construction work;

1.13 FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE CONDITIONS WILL RENDER ANY ACTIVITY CONDUCTED UNLAWFUL, AND THE KWAZULU-NATAL AMAFA AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THIS PERMIT AND TO INSTITUTE CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL ACTION AGAINST THE PERSON/S RESPONSIBLE.

1.14 The issuing of this permit does not exempt the Applicant from compliance with any other law, where applicable.

This permit is valid from 06/02/2023 to 06/02/2026 AND IS NOT TRANSFERABLE.
