- 4. An accurate recording of the rock paintings must be made, including a full photographic record of the site before and after removal of the pigment sample.
- 5. An annual progress report on the results of the excavations and analyses must be submitted to the heritage authority and a final report is due within three years of completion of the analyses.
- 6. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with the heritage authority.
- 7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 9. The heritage authority shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 10. The heritage authority reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
