Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

of: the Mossel Bay Archaeology Project, P O Box 176, Great Brak River, 6525,
for: the export of 20 samples of small flowstones that overlie archaeological contexts as well as 80 samples of non-archaeological samples of flowstones that overlie fossilized dunes, and speleothems that have formed in small crevasses in the coastal cliffs,
from: Pinnacle Point Caves 13B and various samples from Staircase Cave, Klein Brak River, Mossel Bay, Western Cape Province.

for: Ur-series and isotope analysis and visual analysis of samples that will be petrographically sectioned.

3. The samples must be kept for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged. Any sample residues must be returned to South Africa.
4. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 1 April 2007.
5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
6. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
