Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

- for: the thin sectioning and mineral chemical analysis and temporary export of the so-called Badplaas meteorite, as well as 2x polished thick sections and 1 polished thin section of Lichtenberg chondrite for mineral/ chemical analysis; 1x polished thin section of Leeuwfontein L6 chondrite, for shock vein study; 1x polished thin section of Queen Mercy H6, for shock vein study and 1x thin section cut-off of Jakkalsfontein L6 chondrite, for analysis of shock veins,

- 4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof Reimold without the consent of SAHRA.
- 5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 November 2006 at the expense of Prof U Reimold.
- 6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 November 2006.
- 7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
