PGS Heritage (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by Exxaro Coal Mpumalanga (Exxaro NBC Coal) to conduct test excavations within a small, unknown, walled enclosure of approximately 6m x 6m on the farm belonging to Exxaro NBC Coal. The aim of the test excavations will be to ascertain whether or not graves exist in said enclosure. The possible graves are located on remainder of portions 3 & 4 of the farm Eerstelingsfontein 406 JT, Mpumalanga Province. If positive evidence of graves is located, a relocation permit application will follow to exhume and relocate the graves according to the wishes of the next of kin.

Conditions:
