- 3. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the repository, National Museum.
- 4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof R Grun without the consent of SAHRA.
- 5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 September 2006 at the expense of Prof R Grun.
- 6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 September 2006.
- 7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
