The name and qualification of the archaeologist monitoring the site shall be submitted to SAHRA for approval.
- 3. The adjacent Historical Kimberley Mine must be avoided.
- 4. A report from the destruction activities must be submitted to SAHRA by the ECO or the archaeologist monitoring the activities by 30 September 2016.
- 5. Any deviations from the plan must be submitted and approved by SAHRA.
- 6. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 7. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
