**TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT**  
No. 80/05/02/013/52

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

to: Mr DRNM Morris,  
of: the McGregor Museum, PO Box 316, Kimberley, 8300,  
for: the temporary export of tissue samples from burials disturbed outside Gladstone Cemetery,  
from: the McGregor Museum, Kimberley, Northern Cape,  
to: Prof G Maat,  
of: Department of Anatomy, Leyden University Medical Centre, PO Box 9602, Leyden, 2300, Netherlands,  
for: analysis aimed at establishing the health status and thus living conditions of those human remains rescued outside the cemetery.

The following conditions apply:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the McGregor Museum.
3. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the repository, McGregor Museum.
4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof G Maat without the consent of SAHRA.
5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 April 2006 at the expense of Prof G Maat.
6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 April 2006.
7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.

This permit is valid until 1 April 2006.
