- 3. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to fill in excavations and protect sites after the trench has been extended to the satisfaction of the supervising archaeologist and SAHRA.
- 5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder. 6.
