- 4. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 October2004 at the expense of Ms EG Jordan.
- 5. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 October 2004.
- 6. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 7. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 8. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
