## PERMANENT EXPORT PERMIT No.80/05/04/015/52

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

- 2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the Department of Anatomy and Cell Biology, University of the Witwatersrand.
- 3. The samples must be kept for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged.
- 4. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 1 August 2006.
- 5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 6. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
