5. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service unless written instructions to the contrary have been received from the repository, the Kwa-Zulu Natal Museum.
6. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr Geeske Langejans at the University of Leiden without the consent of SAHRA.
7. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before the 30th of November 2013 at the expense of Dr Geeske Langejans.
8. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA on or before the 30th of November 2013.
9. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
10. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
