Issued under Section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

in: the Humansdorp District, Eastern Cape Province.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
- 2. Should any human remains be uncovered during the earth moving phase of construction, all activities should cease on site and a qualified archaeologist should be appointed to assess the site. SAHRA should be notified and the relevant regulations adhered to in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act (25 of 1999).
- 3. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 1 June 2006. SAHRA reserves the right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 6. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
