The following conditions apply:

1. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Should any human remains be uncovered during the earth moving phase of construction, all activities should cease on site and a qualified archaeologist should be appointed to assess the site. SAHRA should be notified and the relevant regulations adhered to in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act (25 of 1999).
3. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 1 June 2006. SAHRA reserves the right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory.
4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
6. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
