PERMIT

Issued under Section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

- to: Michael Chazan in association with David Morris,
- of: the Department of Anthropology, University of Toronto, 100 St George Street, Toronto, Ontario, MSS1A1, Canada and the McGregor Museum, Kimberley, Northern Cape,
- for: sampling for dating and surveying,
- and excavation of square Q32 being the end of a remnant baulk of early deposit in Area 1,
- at: Wonderwerk Cave, at approximately 27.50.45S, 23.33.19E,
- on: the farm Wonderwerk, near Kuruman,
- in: the Kgalagadi/ Ga-Segonyana District, Northern Cape Province.

The following conditions apply:

- 1. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
- 2. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be used. Note that the position of all excavations must be marked on a plan of each site.
- 3. A standard site record form must be lodged with the McGregor Museum.
- 4. Sections should be skimmed to the absolute minimum that will provide results required.
- 5. Location and extent of ESR, U-series and other dating samples MUST be discussed with the McGregor Museum before the work is done.
- 6. All material collected and excavated, as well as survey data, field notes and records, will be curated by the McGregor Museum and in the interim copies of all data must be lodged with them..
- 7. A full final report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 1 January 2008. Before further excavation a full report on progress to date of analysis of the old material will be required. SAHRA reserves the right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory.
- 8. Reprints of all published papers, or copies of theses or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with SAHRA.
- 9. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
- 10. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 11. At the end of each season the permit holder must protect the sampled sections of the site against slumping to the satisfaction of SAHRA and the McGregor Museum.
- 12. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 13. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.

This permit is valid until 1 January 2008.
